as shrubs not trees. Bougainvillea,  
jasmine and any other climbing  
vines\* must be trimmed monthly  
during the summer months and at  
least every 6 week during the winter  
months by the homeowner.**

**\*Note that vines are not allowed to  
encroach on the buildings or trees  
and must be attached to a trellis  
approved in writing by the  
Association.**
